## NEW TRICKS

an easy way to make Card Trick blocks

It's easy because:

Some of the fabric can be precut 2½" strips No marking required Very few bias seams A little room for error

MATERIALS (to make a small quilt about 42"x50")

- · Background: 1/2 yard of a solid or nearly-solid fabric (traditionally white or light)
- Cards: 8 strips 2½xWOF (2 each of 4 fabrics, or 8 different for a scrappy look) These fabrics are your "cards," and they should contrast well with each other and with the background.
- Sashing: ½ yd. of a fabric of your choice (not the same as any of your cards or background)
- · Cornerstones: 2 strips 21/2xWOF, typically an accent color
- Borders: ¼ yd. of coordinating fabric
- Binding: 3/8 yd, or 5 strips 21/xWOF

## **TOOLS & SUPPLIES**

- · Sewing machine ready to stitch straight quarter-inch seams
- · Thread, scissors, pins, and other tools you like to have available
- Rotary cutter and ruler at least 9" long
- Optional: a square-up ruler 9" or larger (available to borrow in class if you don't have one)
