## Mystery Quilt Cutting Instructions

## Please complete the cutting before the workshop!

It is a clever idea to have a box (plastic, pizza or otherwise) to lay everything out. It also helps to label your pieces and keep them together.

Measurements for a small quilt are in parenthesis.
WOF - width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge

## Background fabric:

Cut 56 (40) $21 / 2$ " strips WOF.
Sub cut: 15 (10) strips into 240 (160) - $21 / 2$ " squares.
Sub cut: 24 (17) strips into 72 (49) $12 \frac{112 "}{}$ " strips.
Remaining 16 (12) strips leave as WOF.
Accents:
Fabric A: (Label A\& B fabrics now)
Cut 10 (7) WOF strips $21 / 2$."
Sub cut 2 (1) strips into $21 / 2$ " squares.
Fabric B:
Cut 8 (6) WOF strips 2 1/2"
Layer Cake: (or 10" squares)
Select 30 (20) prints and sub cut each into four $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares, keeping sets together.
Select 8 (6) prints, sub cut each into 4-4 $1 / 2$ " squares.
Border fabric: Can be done after quilt is assembled.
Large: Cut 9 strips - 5 "x WOF
Twin: Cut 7 strips - 3 " x WOF
