## "Layer 'em Up" Supply List



## FABRIC:

- 12 different light fabrics: a $10^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle and an $11^{\prime \prime}$ square
- 12 different dark fabrics: a $10^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle and an $11^{\prime \prime}$ square
- 2 yards of fabric for borders \& binding (either 2 small quilts or one medium size quilt)
- If you aren't sure about fabric choices, call Sharron 828-280-6234 for suggestions.


## CUTTING:

- Rotary cutter with a sharp blade that can cut 6 layers of fabric
- Small cutting mat, such as 12 " $\times 18^{\prime \prime}$
- $2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 18^{\prime \prime}$ ruler OR any ruler at least $2 \frac{1}{2} \times 18^{\prime \prime}$-(to cut fabric for piecing blocks)
- $8^{1 / 2 \prime} \times 8^{1 / 2 \prime}$ " ruler OR any ruler at least that size (for squaring-up blocks)


## SEWING:

- Sewing machine
- Presser foot for sewing $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ straight seams
- Straight pins
- One safety pin
- Fabric marker (chalk or temporary pen)
- Small scissors
- Needle \& thread
- Seam ripper (just in case)
